*(hold hands in front of self)*

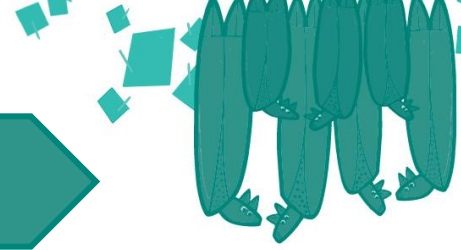
**respecting and acknowledging**

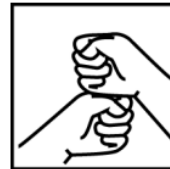

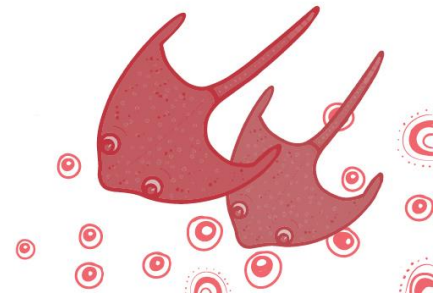

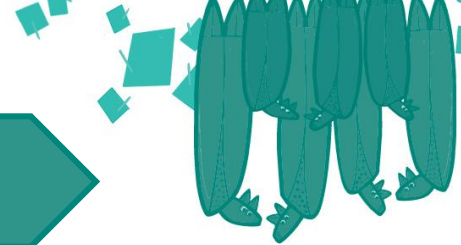

**Maybiya, Maybiya, (May-bee-yah)**

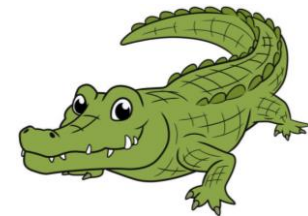
*(snap hands like crocodile)*

# Twinkle Twinkle Little Star

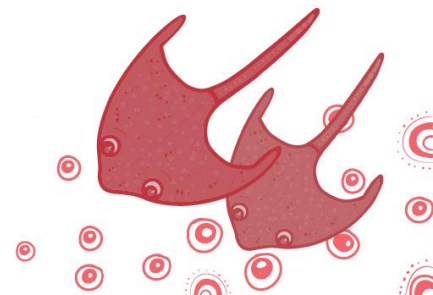
**Twinkle, twinkle little star,**

**How I wonder what you are.**

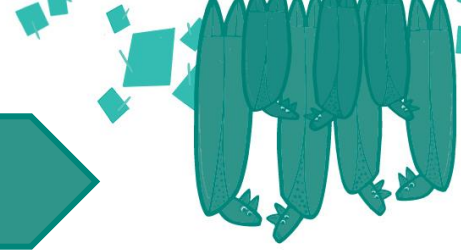
**Up above the world so high,**

*(Peek-a-boo with hands)*





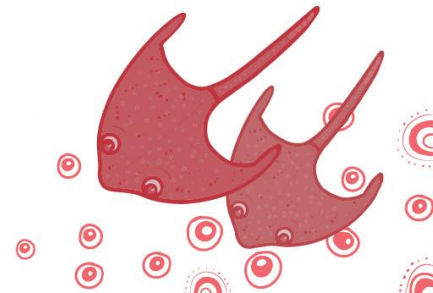
## One Bright Scarf *(fabric song)*
