(hands on chest)


We stand together hand in hand,

Hi, hello and how are you? How are you? How are you? Hi, hello and how are you? How are you today?




Hi = wave




How are you = place palm of open dominant hand on chest. Brush fingertips off chest and close hand with thumb extended.

Two little ears to hear each sound,


(Point to ears)

Look and you'll see them


Come out of the hive,

One bows once, the other bows twice


(Bow fingers)
