(hold hands in front of self)

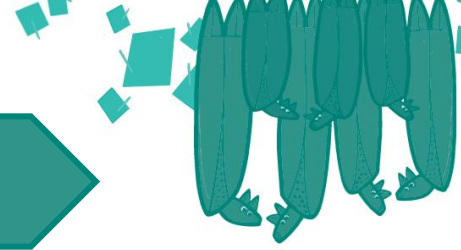
respecting and acknowledging

How are you today?

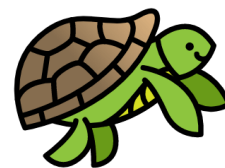


Hi =

up all the soap

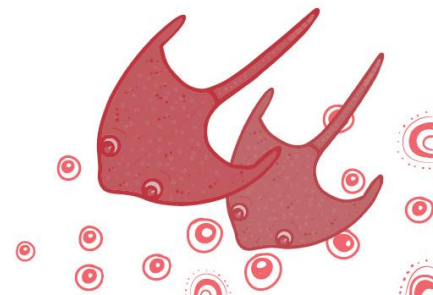


Now he's got bubbles

Down came the rain and washed poor incy out.

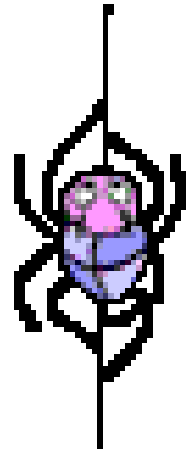
(Bring fingers downward, then sweep hands out)

One named Fred, one named Frank.

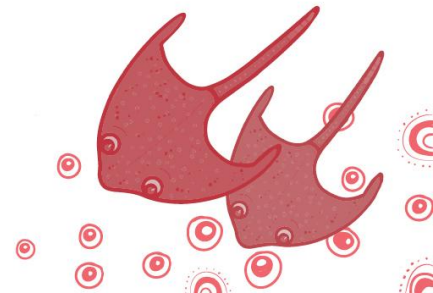
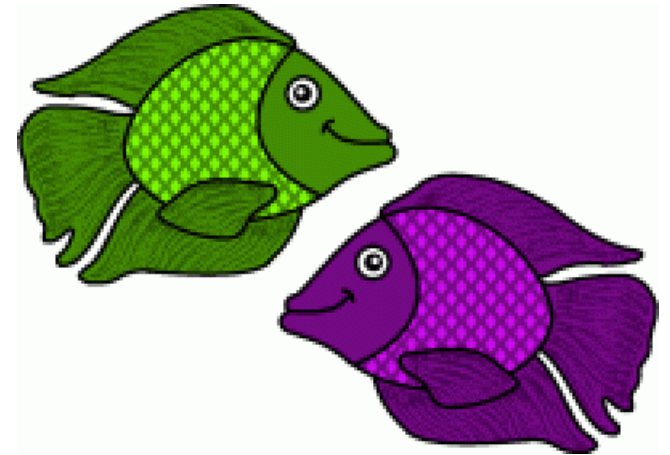
(Move hand forward, one at a time)
