(hold hands in front of self)

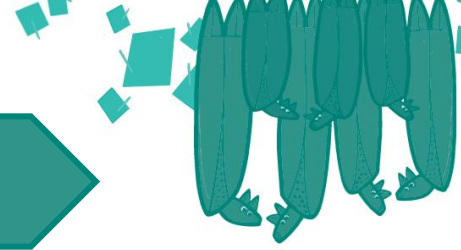

Twinkle Twinkle Little Star

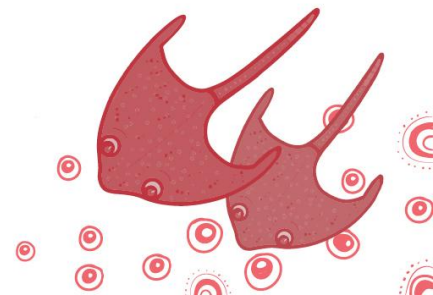
Twinkle, twinkle little star,

Serer em nabawem,

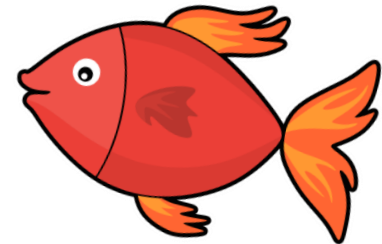
(Left hand to floor, then to right shoulder)

Taba naba norem,

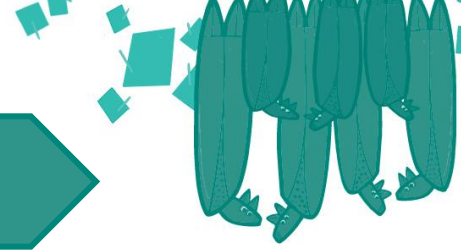
(Both hands up high, then on shoulders, then on hips)

We're going on a bumpy road, a bumpy road, a bumpy road.

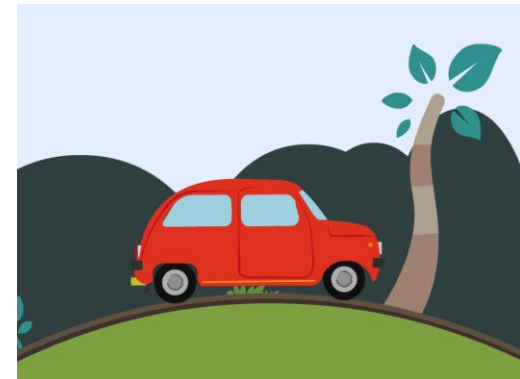
(move fabric up and down faster)

(move fabric up and down really fast)

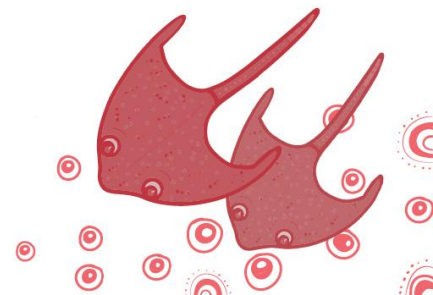
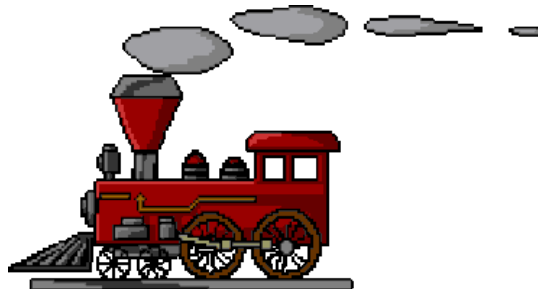
Oh Oh! A pothole! Weeeeeeeeeee!

Choo, choo!

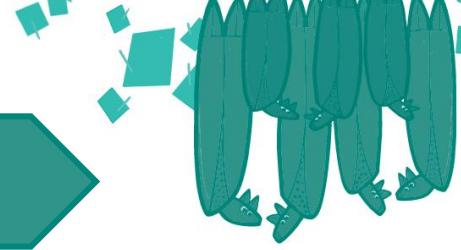


Storytime
